

Communicative worksheet

Talking about interests

1 Ask students what their interests are. Then ask them to complete the expressions on the worksheet and share their ideas with a partner.

2 Ask students to look at the pictures in the story. Ask:

Where are they? What's the event?

What clubs can they join?

What do people do in each of these clubs?

Brainstorm ways of recommending clubs or encouraging people to join them.

Alternative activity

Ask students to tell the story of the two students' visit to the open day, and to say which club they joined and what happened in the end.

3 Ask pairs to choose roles and to prepare expressions that they could use in their dialogue.

With a strong class, ask students to improvise the conversation in pairs.

With a weaker class, ask students to work in pairs to prepare and write a conversation before acting out.

4 Ask some pairs to act out their improvised or prepared conversation for the class. To create a task for the class, write the following question on the board and ask students to listen and find the answers:

Which club do they decide to join?

5 Personalise

Ask students to say which clubs they belong to. Ask them what they like or dislike about the club and which other clubs they would like to join.

6 Writing

Ask students to design an advertisement for a college magazine for one of the college clubs in the picture story.
