Getting Started

Front of the Card

o Main image

Season's greetings

Write a cheerful message like "Merry Christmas!", "Happy Holidays!", "Happy Hanukkah!", "Joyous Kwanzaa!", or "Happy New Year!"

Inside of the Card

o Warm wishes

Write a friendly message for the recipient. You could tell them what you're most looking forward to about the festivities, or share a special memory.

o Personal touch

Draw a little picture, add a sparkly sticker, or sprinkle some glitter to make the card extra special.
